

CODE OF ETHICS

Online Course

This course is free at www.REALTOR.org.

- 1) **Log in as usual. You will need your member ID # (or NRDS #), which is written on your copy of the NVBR membership application form – it begins w/ “8565”. (Note: If you have not registered on this site before, please refer to the box on the right hand side of this screen, “Not Registered?” and Click to register.) If you need further assistance, you can call us at 264-6061.**
- 2) **On the left hand side of the home page, click on “Code of Ethics Training”.**
- 3) **On the next page that pops up, click on “New Member Code of Ethics Orientation Course for new REALTORS®”.**

It will walk you through from that point forward. [There are NO CE credits for this on-line version, but it DOES fulfill the NAR REALTOR® Code of Ethics requirement.]

Please note: Due to the increase in number of REALTORS® taking these courses, you may experience delays in the loading of screens and the submission of the quizzes/ final exam. It is best to take the courses during the evening hours or over the weekends. If the course is terminated for any reason, all progress will be saved up to the last lesson review quiz.

General Information

Time: The course can be completed in one session (approximately 2 1/2 hours), or can be exited after the Quick Review Quiz in any lesson and restarted at the beginning of the next lesson. Failure to complete the Quick Review Quiz prior to exiting the course will require that the lesson be taken over. Individuals have 30 days to complete the course from their original starting date.
